

**USMSC PERSONAL COMPUTER SHIPMENT REPORT
1st FIVE MONTHS 2007**

~ Notebook Shipments Rose 22.1%~

July 10, Washington, DC -- The United States Microcomputer Statistics Committee (USMSC) released its first five months personal computer (PC) shipment data for the United States today.

Total PC shipments amounted to 4.43 million units in May, a drop of about 5.7% from the 4.19 million units shipped in May 2006.

On a year-over-year basis total PC notebook shipments increased by 22.1% from 1.47 million units in May 2006 to 1.8 million units in May 2007. Consumer notebook sales are growing at a rate more than twice that of marketed to business.

PC server shipments slowed in May. Shipments declined by 3.4% to 0.17 million units from 0.18 million in May of last year. Desktop shipments decreased from 2.54 million units in May 2006 to 2.46 million units in May 2007.

The three-month rolling average* for total PC shipments was to 5.15 million units in May compared to 4.89 million during the same period in 2006. USMSC's latest forecast, issued in March 2007, calls for total US PC shipments to increase by 3.1% in 2007.
