We trust that with greater understanding will come public policies that encourage innovation and sustain America's economic growth and leadership in the Information Age. ITI's High Tech Voting Guide is one of only two business group ratings to be published in the Almanac of American Politics.

Description of Key Votes — House:

1. Dreier/Lofgren Amendment to H.R. 1588 – National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) of 2004

This amendment would have repealed cumbersome provisions of the 1998 NDAA that require the Administration to notify Congress of its intent to raise export control levels and to delay implementation of those decisions for 60 days. The amendment would have kept the current millions of theoretical operations (MTOPS) system in place until a replacement system was established. The amendment was defeated by a vote of 207-217. The pro-IT vote was “yes.”

2. H.R. 1113 – Class Action Fairness Act of 2003

This bill's provisions on plaintiff compensation, notices and settlements addressed the worst abuses in the class action process. The provisions on diversity jurisdiction of the federal courts would substantially reduce frivolous lawsuits and forum shopping, while leaving cases that primarily affect in-state plaintiffs to state court jurisdiction. The bill passed by a vote of 253-170. The pro-IT vote was “yes.”

3. H.R. 2739 – U.S.-Singapore Free Trade Agreement Implementation Act

This free trade agreement (FTA) provided precedent-setting benefits to the high tech industry in areas such as e-commerce, services, and intellectual property rights. Products sold electronically by US exporters received permanent duty-free status. This FTA established an important precedent by adopting a comprehensive “negative list” approach where exceptions to liberalization must be specified, and set out high standards of protection and enforcement for copyrights and other intellectual property. The bill passed by a vote of 272-155. The pro-IT vote was “yes.”

4. H.R. 2738 – U.S.-Chile Free Trade Agreement Implementation Act

This free trade agreement (FTA) provided precedent-setting benefits to the high tech industry in areas such as e-commerce, services, tariff reduction, and intellectual property rights. Products sold electronically by U.S. exporters received permanent duty-free status. This FTA established an important precedent by adopting a comprehensive “negative list” approach where exceptions to liberalization must be specified, and set out high standards of protection and enforcement for copyrights and other intellectual property. The bill passed by a vote of 270-156. **The pro-IT vote was “yes.”**

5. S. 877 – Can-SPAM Act of 2004

The Can-SPAM Act requires the Federal Trade Commission to address the growing problem of unsolicited commercial emails. The law amended the Federal code to treat certain deceptive practices associated with “spam” as criminal activities. S. 877 also created a single, preemptive federal standard for the regulation of “spam”. The bill passed by a vote of 392-5. **The pro-IT vote was “yes.”**

6. H.R.1561 – U.S. Patent and Trademark Fee Modernization Act

H.R.1561 ends Patent and Trademark Office (PTO) fee diversion while retaining oversight authority for congressional appropriators. The bill also increases user fees to make available additional funding for needed improvements at the PTO. The bill passed by a vote of 379-28. **The pro-IT vote was “yes.”**

7. H.R. 4520 – American Jobs Creation Act

H.R. 4520 repealed the Extraterritorial Income Exclusion Act (ETI) to comply with our WTO obligations and replaced ETI with a corporate rate cut for domestic manufacturing activities. It contained several other important international tax provisions such as foreign tax credit reforms and incentives to reinvest foreign earnings in the U.S. The bill passed by a vote of 251-178. **The pro-IT vote was “yes.”**

8. H.R. 4759 – U.S.-Australia Free Trade Agreement Implementation Act

This free trade agreement (FTA) provided precedent-setting benefits to the high-tech industry in areas such as e-commerce, services, tariff reduction, and intellectual property rights. Products sold electronically by U.S. exporters received permanent duty-free status. This FTA adopted a comprehensive “negative list” approach where exceptions to liberalization must be specified, set out high standards of protection and enforcement for copyrights and other intellectual property, and won important concessions to open Australia's government procurement market. The bill passed by a vote of 272-155. **The pro-IT vote was “yes.”**

9. H.R. 3574 – Stock Option Accounting Reform Act

H.R. 3574 amends the Securities Act of 1933 to prohibit the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) from recognizing as “generally accepted” any accounting principle relating to the expensing of stock options unless it complies with certain requirements. The bill passed by a vote of 312-111. **The pro-IT vote was “yes.”**

10. American Jobs Creation Act – Conference Report for H.R. 4520

The conference report repealed ETI to comply with our WTO obligations and replaced ETI with a tax deduction for domestic manufacturing activities. It contained several other important international tax provisions such as foreign tax credit reforms and incentives to reinvest foreign earnings in the U.S. The conference report passed by a vote of 280-141. The pro-IT vote was “yes.”

Description of Key Votes — Senate:

1. Motion to Waive C.B.A. re: Ensign Amendment to H.R. 2 – Jobs and Growth Reconciliation Tax Act

The Ensign amendment added a provision to the 2003 stimulus bill (H.R. 2) to create an incentive to invest foreign earnings in the U.S. The amendment was agreed to by a vote of 75-25. The pro-IT vote was “yes.”

2. S.1417 – U.S.-Singapore Free Trade Agreement

Same as House vote summary. The bill passed by a vote of 66-32. The pro-IT vote was “yes.”

3. S.1416 – U.S.-Chile Free Trade Agreement Implementation Act

Same as House vote summary. The bill passed by a vote of 65-32. The pro-IT vote was “yes.”

4. S. 877 – CAN-SPAM Act of 2004

S. 877 required the Federal Trade Commission to address the growing problem of unsolicited commercial emails. The law amended the federal code to treat certain deceptive practices associated with “spam” as criminal activities. S. 877 also created a single, preemptive federal standard for the regulation of “spam”. The bill passed by a vote of 97-0. The pro-IT vote was “yes.”

5. Hatch Amendment to S.1637 – Jumpstart Our Business Strength Act

The Hatch amendment extended the R&D credit through 2005 and expanded the provisions by increasing rates of the alternative incremental research credit. This amendment also enacted a new alternative simplified method for computing benefit under the R&D credit. The amendment was agreed to by a vote of 93-0. The pro-IT vote was “yes.”

6. Breaux Amendment to S.1637 – Jumpstart Our Business Strength Act

The Breaux amendment would have severely restricted the use of funds repatriated under the provisions of the Senate bill. This amendment would also impose severe financial penalties for repatriating funds that were not subsequently invested in the manners specified in the amendment. The amendment was not agreed to by a vote of 31-68. **The pro-IT vote was “no.”**

7. Motion to Invoke Cloture on McCain Amendment to S. 150 – Internet Tax Nondiscrimination Act of 2003

The McCain substitute amendment to S. 150 provided for an additional four years of protection against the imposition of Internet access taxes. Voice over Internet Protocol (VOIP) became a divisive issue throughout the negotiations to pass an Internet tax moratorium. As a result, the vote on cloture for the McCain substitute amendment became a vote on VOIP (i.e., a vote against cloture was a vote for taxing and regulating VOIP). Cloture was invoked by a vote of 64-34. **The pro-IT vote was “yes.”**

8. S. 150 – Internet Tax Nondiscrimination Act of 2003

S. 150, as amended, provided for a 4-year extension of the Internet tax moratorium against access taxes, as well as multiple and discriminatory taxes. S. 150 also provided a 4-year extension to grandfathered states taxing dial-up services prior to 1998 and a 2-year extension of access taxes on Voice Over Internet Protocol (VOIP) services in States already taxing VOIP prior to November 2003. The bill passed by a vote of 93-3. **The pro-IT vote was “yes.”**

9. Motion to Table Dorgan Amendment to S.1637 – Jumpstart Our Business Strength Act

The Dorgan amendment would have imposed current year taxation (denied deferral) on any “imported property income” of a foreign subsidiary of a US corporation. Any income of such subsidiary derived from importing property into the US would have been subject to current year taxation. This provision would have been extremely difficult to administer and ensure compliance, and would significantly limit the concept of deferral which is crucial to the global competitiveness of US industry. The amendment was tabled by a vote of 60-39. **The pro-IT vote was “yes.”**

10. S.1637 – Jumpstart Our Business Strength Act

This bill repealed ETI to comply with our WTO obligations and replaced ETI with a tax deduction for domestic manufacturing activities. It contained several other important international tax reforms such as incentives to reinvest foreign earnings in the U.S., foreign tax credit reforms, and net operating loss provisions. The bill passed by a vote of 92-5. The pro-IT vote was “yes.”

11. S.2610 – U.S.-Australia Free Trade Agreement Implementation Act

Same as House vote summary. The bill passed by a vote of 80-16. The pro-IT vote was “yes.”

12. Jumpstart Our Business Strength Act - Conference Report

Same as House vote summary. The conference report passed by a vote of 69-17.

The pro-IT vote was “yes.”
